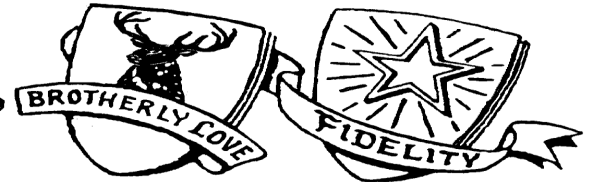
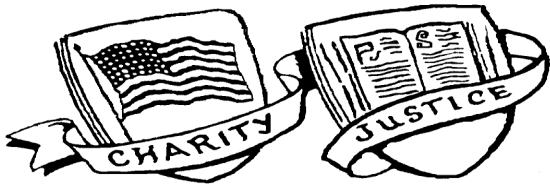
Volunteering is a vital part of our lodge and I appreciate all who step up to volunteer and welcome all members to help out whenever possible.



Awards honor Scouting standouts

Although the Elks Lodges had to end their official relationship with the Boy Scouts as charter or sponsors of a scout unit, Lodges may continue to support scouts by providing use of the Lodge facilities after obtaining a "Facilities Use and Indemnity Agreement" from the local scout unit or council.

Here are some ways the Lodge can be supportive of Scouting:

- Assist with items and materials as needed.
- Formally recognize the Amer-

icanism training of Eagle Scouts by the presentation of a certificate and an American flag. The Scout Court of Honor should be strictly a scout function, not infringed upon by Elks. Grand Exalted Ruler Shook will send a letter and a pin to the Eagle Scout. Grand Lodge will print an attractive certificate. You will need to let the Activities Committee member know so they can get the proper information to Grand Lodge.

- Recognize Girl Scouts with Gold, Silver, and Bronze Awards.

The Gold Award, for high school Girl Scouts, is similar to the Eagle Scout Award for young men. The Silver Award is for cadets in grades 6-8 who have completed the eight-step program. The Bronze Award is for grades 4-5 who complete a seven-step program. Certificates are available at elks.org/grandlodge/activities then click on Forms/Certificates.

• Recognize individuals working in Scouting with a nomination for the Marvin M. Lewis Scouting Award. This recognizes Elks in good standing who contribute significantly to the youth of their communities by volunteering in the programs of the Boy Scouts of America. It is named for PGER Marvin M. Lewis, one

of Elksdom's strongest proponents of Scouting. Each Lodge may nominate one candidate for this award. A Grand Lodge selection committee will re-view the candidates and choose up to four winners. This application, which is due March 1, 2024, is available at elks.org/grandlodge/activities/marvinlewis.cfm.
