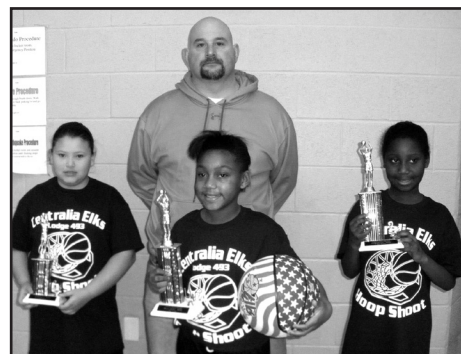
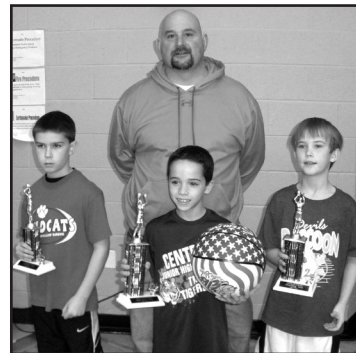
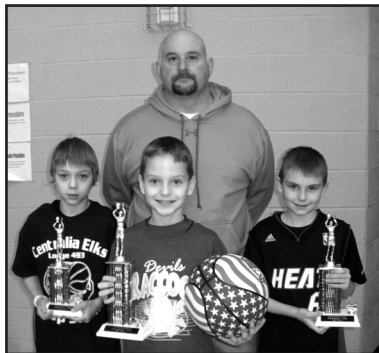
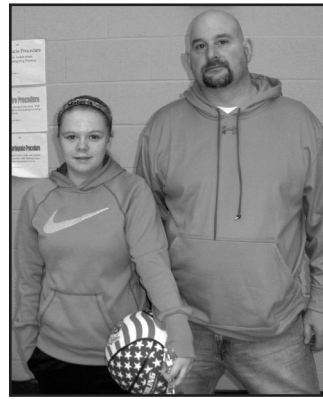
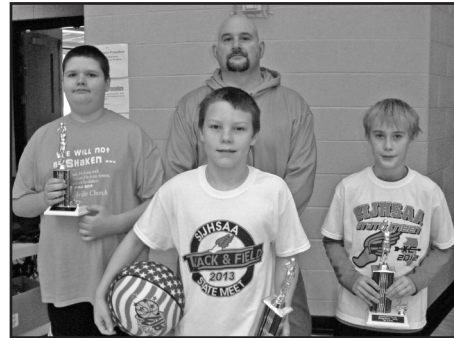


Americanism
