Carmichael Elks Golf Clubhouse



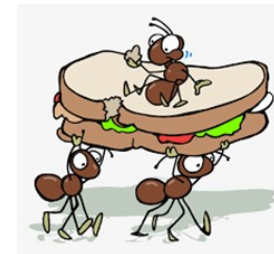
The Carmichael Elks Golf Club members met at the Lodge on Monday, August 1st, 2024, to discuss club business and upcoming events.
